Granting Foreigners Entry Permit Based on Ministry of Law and Human Rights Regulation No.11 of 2020

Directorate General of Immigration stipulated Circular Letter No. IMI-UM.01.01-4047 regarding Granting Foreigners Entry Permit Based on Ministry of Law and Human Rights Regulation (Permenkumham) No. 11 Year 2020 on August 14th 2020. As stated in Permenkumham Article 2 and article 3 paragraph (1) letters d and f provide exceptions to the provisions for prohibiting entry to Indonesian territory, namely for medical aid and support personnel, food and humanitarian reasons as well as foreigners who will work on Strategic Projects National (PSN).

Further, within the circular letter the director general of immigration informed that the Ministry of Law and Human Rights, Ministry of Manpower and Indonesia Investment Coordinating Board (BKPM) agreed on the need for strategic steps to be realized, including by granting discretionary entry permits as referred to in Article 6 Permenkumham Number 11 Year 2020 against Foreign Workers (TKA) who work outside PSN and foreigners who visit Indonesian territory for investment.

The implementation of granting entry permits as intended is carried out through the granting of visit visas and limited stay visas, for this reason the Directorate General of Immigration issues visa approval (telex) for foreigners which is used as a requirement in visa applications at Indonesian Representatives. In addition, visit visas and limited stay visas that are issued based on the telex visa above can be used to travel to Indonesian territory in accordance with the laws and regulations.
