The Extension of Enforcement of Restrictions on Community Activities (PPKM) Java-Bali to January 24th, 2022

According to the press conference held by Secretariat of the President of the Republic of Indonesia on January 16th, 2022, the Coordinating Minister for Maritime Affairs and Investment, Luhut B. Pandjaitan announced about the extension on the regulations of the implementation of Emergency Community Activity Restriction (PPKM) in Java-Bali **effective from January 18th to January 24th 2022**. The extension is affirmed in the Instruction of the Minister of Home Affairs (Inmendagri) No. 3 Year 2022 on the Enactment of Restrictions on Community Activities Level 3, Level 2 and Level 1 Corona Virus Disease 2019 in Java and Bali.

The government will also carry out PPKM assessments which are evaluated every week and remove the two-week assessment. Further, there are several adjustment on the regulations of PPKM in Java-Bali, include:

- 1. The Implementation of learning in the education units can be done through limited face-to-face learning and/or distance learning.
- 2. The implementation of activities in the non-essential sector is applied to a maximum of 25 percent of Work From Office (WFO) for employees who have been vaccinated and are required to use the PeduliLindungi application at the entrance and exit of the workplace;
- 3. The implementation of shopping activities can operate with a maximum capacity of 75 percent until 21:00 local time and must use the PeduliLindungi application.
- 4. The implementation of activities in shopping centers / malls / trading centers are opened with a maximum capacity of 50 percent until 21:00 local time and must use the PeduliLindungi application.
- 5. The implementation of activities in places of worship are limited to a maximum of 75 percent capacity by implementing health protocols. Meanwhile, public facilities are allowed to be opened with a maximum capacity of 25 percent with health protocols.
- 6. Public transportation, mass transit, online taxis, rental vehicles, and aircraft are allowed with a maximum capacity of 100 and implementing strict health protocols.

As emphasized before, the government still urges people to remain compliant with health protocols though the current positive cases of Covid-19 continue to decrease by always implementing 3M (wear a mask, washing hands, keep the distance and avoid the crowd) and 3T (testing, tracing, and treatment).
