Update Procedure of Visa on Arrival (VoA) in Bali during the Covid19 Pandemic Effective from March 7, 2022

On Sunday, March 6th, 2022, the Governor of Bali, Wayan Koster gave a statement that the Visa on Arrival (VOA) has been applied for the international travelers (PPLN) and the quarantine for the PPLN who visit Bali have been revoked and declared invalid. This statement is supported by the Secretary of Bali Provincial Government, Dewa Made Indra through his welcoming remarks for the VOA guidelines.

The VoA is the primary visa that has been used for most tourists in the last decades to enter Indonesia. The government decided that the 23 listed countries can obtain a Visa on Arrival in Bali, and will be only valid for the international travelers who **directly arrive in Bali (not Jakarta or other airports)**. Further, the VOA is valid for 30 days and can be extended once for 30 days.
