

The Minister of Trade, Muhammad Lutfi issued the Ministry of Trade Regulation No. 8 Year 2022 about the Second Amendment to the Regulation of the Minister of Trade No. 19 Year 2021 concerning Export Policies and Regulations that effective starting from **February 15th**, **2022**.

There are several highlighted points in the Minister of Trade Regulation No. 8 Year 2022, namely:

- 1. The issuance of export licenses must be based on the amount for distribution of domestic market obligation and domestic price obligation.
- 2. Permits or approval of exports of crude palm oil, refined, bleached, and deodorized palm olein and used cooking oil as well as other fuels in the form of biodiesel **are automatically deactivated** by the Director General on behalf of the Minister through the INATRADE System.
- 3. Export permits or approvals will be reactivated if the exporter has submitted the realization of distribution adjusted to the amount for distribution of domestic market obligation and domestic price obligation.
- 4. Exporters who are in the process of submitting business approvals in the export sector of crude palm oil, refined, bleached, and deodorized palm olein, and used cooking oil, as well as other fuel export approvals must comply with the provisions in this Ministerial regulation.

With the enactment of this regulation, the Ministry of Trade Regulation No. 19 Year 2021 about the Export Policies and regulations is revoked and declared invalid.
