The Update Entry Points for International Travelers According to the Circular Addendum No. 22 Year 2022

The COVID-19 Task Force issued a Circular Addendum No. 22 Year 2022 about the Overseas Travel Health Protocol During Pandemic Corona Virus Disease 2019 (Covid-19) on 15 July 2022. This regulation is effective on 21 August 2022 with a specified time later and will be evaluated further according to the needs. The purpose of this Circular Addendum is to add an entry point overseas travel and to prevent the spread of Covid-19.

Previously, there were 16 (sixteen) airports entry points, and currently there is 1 (one) new airport entry point, Sultan Syarif Kasim II Airport in Riau which has been added to the list.

Below are the 17 (seventeen) the international airport entry points:

Airport:

1. Soekarno Hatta, Banten;
2. Juanda, East Java;
3. Ngurah Rai, Bali;
4. Hang Nadim, Riau Islands;
5. Raja Haji Fisabilillah, Riau Islands;
6. Sam Ratulangi, North Sulawesi;
7. Zainuddin Abdul Majid, West Nusa Tenggara;
8. Kualanamu, North Sumatra;
9. Sultan Hasanuddin, South Sulawesi;
10. Yogyakarta, Special Region of Yogyakarta;
11. Sultan Iskandar Muda, Aceh;
12. Minangkabau, West Sumatra;
13. Sultan Mahmud Badaruddin II, South Sumatra;
14. Adisumarmo, Central Java;
15. Syamsuddin Noor, South Kalimantan;
16. Sultan Aji Muhammad Sulaiman Sepinggan, East Kalimantan; and
17. Sultan Syarif Kasim II, Riau.
