Updates on Health Protocols for Domestic Travel During the 2019 Corona Virus Disease Pandemic

The COVID-19 Task Force issued a Circular Letter (SE) No. 24 Year 2022 concerning Provisions for Domestic Travelers (PPDN) During the 2019 Corona Virus Disease Pandemic on 25th August 2022. This circular letter regulates the adjustments of mandatory booster vaccine for PPDN and mandatory second dose vaccine for foreign citizens. This regulation is effective from 25th August 2022.

The Circular Letter No. 24 Year 2022 stipulates:

- 1. Domestic travellers (PPDN) are required to use the PeduliLindungi application as a condition to travel domestically
- 2. PPDN over the age of 18 must have received the third dose of vaccine or booster vaccine
- 3. PPDN over the age of 18 with the status of a Foreign Citizen (WNA), originating from overseas travel must have **received the second dose of vaccine**
- 4. PPDN aged 6-17 years must have received the second dose of vaccine
- 5. PPDN aged 6-17 years old from overseas travel are exempted from the obligation to have received the second dose of vaccine, with condition they must travel with a companion who has received the third dose of vaccine
- 6. PPDN is not required to show a negative result of the RT-PCR or rapid antigen test
- 7. PPDN with special health conditions or comorbid diseases are excluded from the vaccination requirements and are not required to show a negative result of the RT-PCR test, but are required to show a letter of statement from doctor or hospital
- 8. These provisions are excluded for PPDN users of pioneer transportation modes including in border areas, outermost areas, and limited shipping

With the enactment of this circular letter, the Circular Letter of the COVID-19 Task Force No. 23 Year 2022 concerning Provisions for Travel of Domestic People during the 2019 Corona Virus Disease Pandemic is **revoked and declared invalid.**
