Updates Summary of the Cosmetic Ingredients Technical Requirements Based on BPOM Socialization On 21 September 2022

On 21 September 2022, the Indonesian Food and Drug Authority (BPOM) was holding a socialization in discussing about the Indonesian Food and Drug Authority (BPOM) Regulation No. 17 Year 2022 concerning the Amendments to BPOM Upper Regulation No. 23 Year 2019 concerning Technical Requirements for Cosmetic Ingredients.

The amendment of this regulation aims to protect the public from cosmetics that do not meet the requirements and several provisions regarding the technical requirements of cosmetic ingredients need to be adjusted to the development of science and technology in the field of cosmetics in accordance with the new rules in 2021 ASEAN Cosmetic Directive at the 34<sup>th</sup> ASEAN Cosmetics meeting Committee.

In this socialization, there are two highlighted points that have been changed in the BPOM Regulation No. 17 Year 2022, as follows:

- 1. The changes of articles are including:
  - Article 1 some definitions have been changed
  - Article 4 clause has been changed
  - Article 8 clause has been changed
  - Article 9A and Article 9B the additional clauses have been added
  - Article 10 clause has been changed
  - Article 11 clause has been changed

Therefore, besides the other articles mentioned above, the rest is still remaining the same in BPOM 23 Year 2019.

- 2. The changes of Appendix/Lampiran are including:
  - Attachment 1: a list of materials that are permitted to be used with restrictions and conditions of use (all materials may be used with a note that they can only be used after obtaining approval based on the results of the study by the OTSKK standardization directorate). A total of 218 materials are listed in Attachment 1.

Changes in Attachment 1: formaldehyde was moved to Attachment 5 (which means that formaldehyde is now prohibited from being used), climbazole can be used as a rinse conditioner with a max. 0.5%, addition of 14 new ingredients with limited use, changes in requirements/editors (due to typo)

• Attachment 2: list of permitted coloring agents in cosmetics. A total of 158 materials are listed in Attachment 2. In addition to materials outside of attachment 2 which are natural materials in Indonesia that can be used as dyes, they can still be used as dyes with a note that they can only be used after obtaining approval.

Changes in Attachment 2: changes in requirements for Hg contamination in material no. 129 & 130

• Attachment 3: list of permitted preservatives in cosmetics. In total there are 57 ingredients listed in Attachment 3. Apart from natural ingredients materials in Attachment 3 in Indonesia that can be used as preservatives after obtaining approval.

Changes in Attachment 3: the additional information on preamble no. 4, changing the biphenyl-2-ol setting, changing the climbazole requirements, removing formaldehyde paraformaldehyde, adjusting the editor, changing the requirements for Polyaminopropyl biguanide, and adding 1 new ingredient

• Attachment 4: list of permitted sunscreen ingredients in cosmetics. A total of 32 ingredients are listed in Attachment 4. Apart from natural ingredients materials of Attachment 4 in Indonesia can be used as sunscreen ingredients after obtaining approval.

Changes in Attachment 4: addition of 3 new ingredients

Attachment 5: list of ingredients that are not permitted in cosmetics. In total there are approximately 1600 ingredients.
Changes in Attachment 5: editorial adjustments/improvements, unification of ingredients into 1 so as not to be redundant, and addition of 231 ingredients that are not permitted to be used in cosmetics.

With the enactment of this BPOM regulation No. 17 Year 2022, the business actors who already have a cosmetic notification number must comply with the provisions in this regulation **no later than 24 months** from the promulgation of this regulation on 28 July 2022 to make a transition period until **28 July 2024**.
