The Summary Updates on the Implementation and Preparation of 2023 Commodity Balance in Indonesia According to the Ministry of Economic Affair Socialization on 19 September 2022

The Ministry for Economic Affairs held a socialization regarding the implementation and preparation of commodity balance to speed up the ease of export and import licensing processes on 19 September 2022. This socialization was intended for business actors to be able to submit their Proposals for the Needs for next year's commodity balance.

In this socialization, there are three highlighted points of the implementation and preparation of the 2023 commodity balance, as follows:

- A. The determination of commodities is carried out in phases with a total of 56 commodity groups. There are 24 commodity groups that are approved and ready to be implemented in the commodity balance, as follows:
  - Phase I of 2021 stipulates 5 commodities groups:
    - 1. Rice
    - 2. Sugar
    - 3. Beef
    - 4. Salt
    - 5. Fishery
  - b. Phase II of 2022 stipulates 19 commodity groups:
    - Steel Alloy Steel Derivative Products
    - 2. Tires
    - 3. Plastic Raw Material
    - 4. Raw Material for Alcoholic Drinks
    - 5. Cell Phones, Handheld Computers, and Tablet Computers
    - 6. Electronics (AC)
    - 7. Colour Multifunction Machines, Colour Copiers and Colour Printers
    - 8. Corn (STRANAS PK)
    - 9. Lubricant Raw Material
    - 10. Saccharin and Cyclamate
    - 11. Clinker Cement and Cement
    - 12. Footwear
    - 13. Raw Materials for Masks and Masks
    - 14. Textile and Textile Products
    - 15. Textile and Textile Products with Batik and Batik Motifs
    - 16. Apparel and Apparel Accessories
    - 17. Other Fuels
    - 18. Fuel Oil
    - 19. Natural Gas
- B. As for the other 32 commodity groups based on the evaluation for the implementation of the commodity balance, it was stated that at this phase they were not ready for the issuance of Export Approval and Import Approval by Ministries/Agencies.
- Business actors are required to carry out the application submitted no later than September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022 because it will be reviewed and the Plan of Needs will be determined by the Ministry/Sector Development Agency for 24 commodities (5 commodities in Phase I and 19 commodities in Phase II) consisting of:
  - a. Ministry of Industry
  - b. Ministry of Marine Affairs and Fisheries
  - c. Food Security Agency, Ministry of Agriculture
  - d. Ministry of Energy and Mineral Resources

For all business actors whose commodities have been determined can fill out the Proposals for the Needs through SiNas NK using a single window national institution account with a deadline for filling out until the end of September. The procedure for accessing SiNas NK is as follows:

- 1. Filling in the proposed needs has been opened in the National Commodity Balance System (https://neracakomoditas.insw.go.id/);
- 2. Access to SiNaS NK using LNSW account or Ministry/Agency system account;
- 3. The deadline for filling in data/information on the proposed Plan of Needs is September 30, 2022 at 23.59 WIB;
- 4. Repairs/fulfilments can be made after the deadline for the Proposals for the Needs of September 30<sup>th</sup> 2022 for business actors who have received an application number;
- 5. Changes/new submissions can be made after the commodity balance is established.

After requesting Proposals for the Needs with a maturity date of 30 September 2022, the relevant Ministries/Agencies will determine the Plan of Needs until 31 October 2022 before the commodity balance is determined in December 2022. Please take note that at any time the commodity balance may change due to natural disasters, non-natural disasters, new investments, government priority programs, and/or other conditions.
