Updates on FMD Susceptible Animal Traffic Rules Based on the Vaccination Status

The Food and Mouth Disease (FMD) Task Force issued a Circular Letter No. 7 Year 2022 concerning the traffic of FMD-susceptible animals and FMD-susceptible animal products on a territorial basis. This regulation is effective from **12 November 2022**. Previously, **regulations on the traffic of FMD susceptible animals only apply for trade purposes between provinces** as referred at The FMD Task Force Circular Letter No. 6 Year 2022. Currently, regulations on the traffic of FMD susceptible animals apply for trade purposes both between provinces and within the province as referred at The FMD Task Force Circular Letter No. 7 Year 2022.

These regulations include several general provisions for the traffic of FMD susceptible animals, namely;

- 1. The Animals have received at least 1 (one) dose of the FMD vaccine;
- 2. The Animals are healthy livestock with an Animal Health Certificate (SKKH) and/or Veterinary Certificate (SV) issued before departure and have a history of animal health; and
- 3. The Animals have applied disinfection, decontamination, and strict Biosecurity Security Measures for transportation equipment, goods, officers and breeders before departure, during travel, and until destination.

The regulation on the traffic of FMD susceptible animals based on animal vaccination status is expected to further increase the rate of FMD vaccination nationally so that the target of establishing herd immunity in FMD susceptible animal populations can be achieved. This regulation is effective from 12 November 2022 until further informed.
