Updates on BNPB Circular Letter on The Travel Ban Extension of Foreigners Entering Indonesia to February 9th 2021

On February 9th 2021, the National Covid-19 Handling Task Force issued a Circular Letter No. 8 Year 2021 on International Travel Health Protocol Amid the Covid-19 Pandemic. This regulation is an extension of the previous regulation in Circular No. 6 Year 2021 which has ended on 8 February 2021.

Prohibition for foreign citizens entering Indonesian territory either direct flights or transit, except those that meet criteria including, in accordance with the provisions of the Regulation of the Minister of Law and Human Rights No. 26 Year 2020 concerning Visas and Stay Permits in a New Adaptation Habit Period, in accordance with the bilateral Travel Corridor Arrangement (TCA) scheme, and obtaining special consideration / permission in writing from the Ministry / Institution. Further, international travelers have to show negative results through the RT-PCR test within a maximum period of 3 x 24 hours. Upon arrival, international travelers are required to undergo quarantine for 5 x 24 hours at a quarantine accommodation certified by the Ministry of Health at full-self expense. After quarantine for 5 days, RT-PCR will be re-examined. This circular is valid starting from **February 9th, 2021** until further informed date and will be evaluated every two weeks or according to the situation.
