Updates on the extension of Enforcement of Restrictions on Community Activities (PPKM) Java-Bali to September 20, 2021

As reported from the press conference held on September 13th, 2021 by the Minister of Coordinating Ministry for Maritime Affairs and Investment, Luhut Pandjaitan who announced that the PPKM Java-Bali is extended again from September 14th until September 20th, 2021.

As a result of the PPKM to date, it is noted that the increase in positive cases of Covid-19 in Java-Bali has fallen by 96% from the highest cases on July 15, and active cases have fallen below 100 thousand people. It was also stated that the government had succeeded in reducing Bali to PPKM Level 3. The total recovery in Java and Bali from September 7-12 has reached 27,392 cases. With this development, some adjustments will be carried out by the government, including:

1. The opening of cinemas with a maximum capacity of 50% in cities level 2 and 3, with the obligation to use the PeduliLindungi application.
2. The encouragement to increase compliance with the PeduliLindungi application in industrial locations.
3. The addition of the opening of tourist sites with strict procedures and the implementation of the PeduliLindungi application in PPKM level 3 cities.
4. The application of odd-even license plates will be implemented in tourist areas from Friday 12.00 AM to Sunday 18.00 PM.
5. The tightening of requirements for international travel from abroad, with the provision of mandatory complete doses of vaccines, 3 times PCR test, quarantine for 8 days, and restrictions on entrances for ease of supervision. The entry route from the air is only through Cengkareng and Manado, while Bali is still being considered.

Furthermore, the minister also re-emphasized the 3 main keys to living a normal, that is including:

1. High vaccination coverage for vulnerable groups such as the elderly.
2. The optimization of centralized isolation handling.
3. The applicability of health protocols in all components of society by implementing 3M;
 - Wear a mask (Memakai Masker)
 - Washing hands (Mencuci Tangan)
 - Keep the distance and avoid the crowd (Menjaga jarak dan Menjauhi kerumunan)

If the vaccination coverage is still low, the 3 main strategies above will be added with PPKM.
