**Circular Letter of the COVID -19 Response Acceleration Task Force No. 22 Year 2021 Concerning Conditions of Domestic Travel during the Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19) Pandemic**

In accordance with the Circular Letter of the COVID-19 Response Acceleration Task Force No. 22 Year 2021 concerning Provisions for Domestic Travel during the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Pandemic, the rules for domestic travel with various modes of transportation, ranging from **land, sea, train, to plane**, have been re-updated. The provisions are effective from Tuesday, November 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2021.

Referring to Circular Letter of the COVID-19 Response Acceleration Task Force No. 22 Year 2021, travelers by sea, land transportation (using private or public vehicles), crossings and inter-city trains must meet the following conditions:

1. It is mandatory to use the PeduliLindungi application
2. Attach a vaccine card (at least the first dose)
3. Negative results of RT-PCR 3x24 hours or negative results of rapid antigen 1x24 hours before departure.
4. For routine trips by land transportation modes using private or public vehicles, and trains in 1 urban agglomeration area are excluded from the above conditions.

While the provisions for long-distance travel by plane are as follows:

1. Travelers from and to areas in Java and Bali and between cities within Java and Bali are required to show:
  - It is mandatory to use the PeduliLindungi application
  - Attach a vaccine card (at least the first dose)
  - Negative result of RT-PCR 3x24 hours (for those who have just vaccinated the first dose)
  - Negative result of rapid antigen 1x24 hours before departure (for those who have been fully vaccinated with two doses)
2. For inter-district or inter-city travel outside Java-Bali, travelers are required to show:
  - It is mandatory to use the PeduliLindungi application
  - Attach a vaccine card (at least the first dose)
  - Negative results of RT-PCR 3x24 hours or negative results of rapid antigen 1x24 hours before departure

As in the latest regulations, the obligation to show a vaccine card is excluded for:

1. Travelers under 12 years old
2. Logistics vehicles and other goods transportation operators who travel outside Java and Bali
3. Travelers with special health conditions or comorbid illnesses that cannot receive the vaccine. Instead, it is mandatory to attach a doctor's certificate from the Government Hospital stating that the person concerned has not and/or is unable to take part in the COVID-19 vaccination.
