Summary of 2021 G20 Summit in Rome, Indonesia Officially Host G20 Presidency in 2022

On October 30<sup>th</sup> 2021, President Jokowi accompanied by the ministers including the Coordinating Minister for Economic Affairs, Airlangga Hartanto; the Minister of State-owned Enterprises, Erick Thohir; and the Cabinet Secretary, Pramono Anung officially attended the G20 Summit in La Nuvola, Rome, Italy. During this event, President Jokowi accepted Indonesia's G20 Presidency's baton symbolically handed over by the Italian Prime Minister, Mario Draghi. This development marks Indonesia's first G20 Presidency, a global forum in which member countries contribute to 80% of the world's GDP.

Indonesia's road to the first G20 Presidency will be summarized:

- 21-22<sup>nd</sup> November 2020;**  
Indonesia's Presidency of G20 Summit in 2022 was announced at the 15<sup>th</sup> Riyadh Summit.
- 1<sup>st</sup> December 2020;**  
Italy assumes the G20 Presidency from Saudi Arabia in December 2020.
- 27<sup>th</sup> May 2021;**  
President Jokowi released Presidential Decree (Keppres) No. 12 Year 2021 concerning the National Committee for the Organizing of the Indonesian G20 Presidency.
- 27<sup>th</sup> June 2021;**  
The Indonesian Minister of Foreign Affairs, Retno Marsudi meetings with the Italian Minister of Foreign Affairs, Luigi Di Maio and the Canadian Minister of Foreign Affairs, Marc Garneau in Rome discuss the Indonesia's G20 Presidency in 2022.
- 29<sup>th</sup> October 2021;**  
The establishment of Joint Finance-Health Task Force to strengthen pandemic prevention, preparedness, and response under the Italy's G20 Presidency
- 30-31<sup>st</sup> October 2021;**  
President Jokowi and world leaders attended the G20 Summit in La Nuvola, Rome, Italy from 30 to 31<sup>st</sup> October 2021. It is reported that the world leaders also attended several side events and meetings on SMEs support, women-owned businesses, climate change and environment, cultural events, and the state dinner event hosted by the Prime Minister Mario Draghi.
  - The Italian Prime Minister Mario Draghi symbolically handed over the G20 Presidency's baton to President Jokowi.
  - Indonesia officially assumes the G20 Presidency in 2022 from Italy.

Indonesia's G20 Presidency will last for a year that starts from 1<sup>st</sup> December 2021 to 30<sup>th</sup> November 2022 with the theme 'Recover Together, Recover Stronger'. Indonesia prepares to hold a series of meetings consist of the Ministerial and Central Bank Governor-level meetings, the Sherpa-level meetings, the Deputy-level meetings, the Working Group-level meetings, the Engagement Group-level meetings, the Side Events program, the Road to G20 Indonesia 2022 program, and the Summits.

In addition, President Jokowi congratulates the Italy for successfully holding the G20 Summit and invites world leaders to continue the discussions at the Indonesia's G20 Summit plan to be held in Bali 30<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> October 2022.
