Summary of Indonesia Investment Realization in 2022

The Ministry of Investment Coordinating Board (Badan Koordinasi Penanaman Modal/BKPM) released the Investment Guidebook 2022 in regard to investment realization in Indonesia throughout 2022. The realization of investment in Indonesia indicates an improved performance from the previous year. Data from BKPM shows the investment value in January-December 2022, both from Domestic Direct Investment (DDI) and Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) reached IDR 1.207,2 trillion, which means it exceeded the investment targeted of IDR 1.200 trillion for 2022.

The summary of FDI and DDI from Q1-Q4 is as follows:

1. In Q1, based on the sector, DDI dominated by Transportation, Warehouses, and Telecommunication. Meanwhile, the FDI is dominated by Metal Industry, Metal Goods, Mining, Electricity, Gas, Water Supply, and Transportation.
2. In Q2, based on the sector, DDI is dominated by Transportation, Warehouses, Telecommunication, Mining, Housing, Industrial Estate, Office Building, Food Crops, Plantations, Livestock and Food Industry. Meanwhile, the FDI is dominated by the Metal Industry, Metal Goods, Mining, Electricity, Gas, Water Supply, and Transportation.
3. In Q3, based on the sector, the DDI and FDI are dominated by Basic Metal Sector, Metal Goods, Non-Machine and Equipment Industrial Sector including Transportation, and Warehouses.
4. In Q4, based on the sector, DDI is dominated by Industry and Office Estates, Housing, Food industry, Mining, Transportation, Warehouses, Telecommunications, and Communications. Meanwhile, FDI is dominated by the Basic Metal Industry, Metal Products, Non-Machinery and Equipment, Chemical and Pharmaceutical Industry, Mining, Transportation, Warehouses, and Telecommunications.

Based on the investment location, DDI is primarily concentrated in the regions of Jakarta, West Java, Riau, East Java and Central Sulawesi. Meanwhile, FDI is primarily concentrated in the regions of Jakarta, West Java, Riau, Central Sulawesi, and North Maluku.

Based on the investors' country of origin, FDI is dominated by China, Singapore, Malaysia, Hongkong United States, and Japan.
