Summary of the National Long-Term Development Plan (Rencana Pembangunan Jangka Panjang Nasional/RPJPN) 2025-2045 by BAPPENAS

The Ministry of National Development Planning (Badan Perencanaan Pembangunan Nasional/BAPPENAS) held a socialization on the *National Long-Term Development Plan (Rencana Pembangunan Jangka Panjang Nasional/RPJPN) 2025-2045* and *Technocratic National Medium-Term Development Plan (RPJMN) 2025-2029* on 9 October 2023. During the meeting, the Minister of National Development Planning, Suharso Manoaarfa announced the government plans for 6 (six) priority of industrial sectors to support Indonesia's Gross Domestic Product (GDP) in the RPJPN 2025-2045. The RPJPN plan aims to boost the economic growth of Indonesia, to address the deindustrialization issue, and to elevate Indonesia to a developed country.

The 6 (six) priority industrial sectors are as below:

1. Natural resource-based industries
2. Basic industries
3. Medium-high technology industries
4. Sustainable consumer goods industries
5. Innovation and research-based industries
6. Creative industries

In addition, according to the BAPPENAS's data record as of 2022, Indonesia's GDP was at USD 4.580 million and still holds the status of an upper-middle income country. This record is also supported by the World Bank data, where the upper middle-income country's GDP per capita ranging from USD 4.466 million to USD 13.845 million. Indonesia can be a developed country but has to reach USD 13.845 million.

The government also aims to raise the manufacturing sector's contribution to GDP to 28% by 2045, and plans to achieve this through regulatory simplification, legal certainty, business competition strengthening, and institutional competition enhancement.
